

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4. How long were Noah and his family in the Ark?

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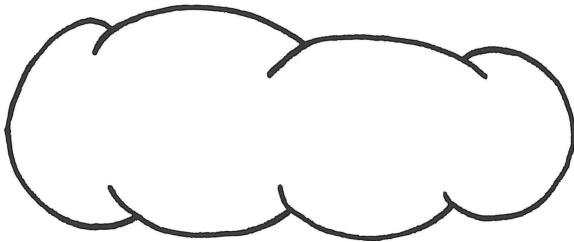
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5. What did Noah do after he got out of the Ark?

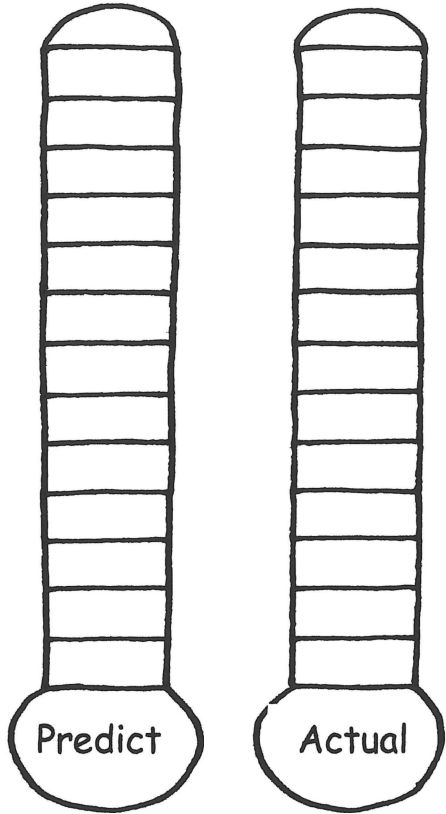

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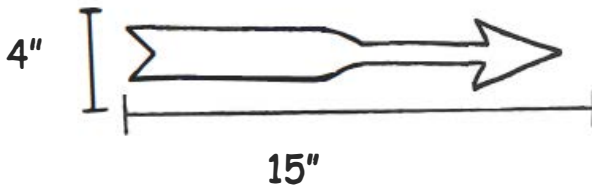
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## Section 5
